**RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BROCK NO. 64****BYLAW NO. 2024-06****A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A HAY SALVAGE POLICY**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Brock No. 64, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

**PURPOSE**

The purpose of this Bylaw is to establish policies for the salvage of hay from roads and road allowances under the control of the Rural Municipality of Brock No. 64.

**DEFINITIONS**

In this Bylaw:

1. "R.M." shall mean the Rural Municipality of Brock No. 64
2. "Municipal Road(s)" shall mean any roads and road allowances under the control of the Rural Municipality of Brock No. 64.

**SHORT NAME**

This Bylaw may be referred to as the "Hay Salvaging Bylaw."

**GENERAL**

1. The adjacent landowner, or lessee in the case of rented land, has first opportunity to salvage hay along Municipal roads. Other persons must contact the adjacent landowner or lessee to salvage the hay on or before July 15<sup>th</sup> of each year.
2. After July 15<sup>th</sup>, any person may cut and salvage hay without the permission of the adjacent landowner or lessee, provided the adjacent landowner or lessee has not begun salvage operations.
3. The Municipal Road(s) must be left in a neat appearance by the person salvaging the hay.
4. Bales of hay must be at least 8 metres from the edge of the shoulder of the Municipal Road(s).
5. All bales must be removed from the Municipal Road(s) by September 1 of each year.
6. The Council reserves the right for its members, employees and/or agents to enter upon the Municipal Road(s) for the purpose of maintenance and/or re-construction of said roadway; or for other purposes as may be deemed necessary; and at no compensation for reimbursement to the party salvaging the hay therefrom.
7. The R.M. assumes no liability for labourers, machinery or bales relating to the salvage of hay operations.
8. Any bales not removed by September 1 may be removed by the R.M. and any bales removed by the R.M. shall become property of the R.M.
9. No person shall cut hay on any portion of a public highway located in this R.M. during the period from one-half (1/2) hour after sunset until one-half (1/2) hour before sunrise.
10. No person shall cut hay on any portion of the Municipal Road(s) located in this R.M. so as to obstruct the travelled portion of the Municipal Road(s).

**REPEAL**

Bylaw No. 91-65 is hereby repealed.
