

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BROCK NO. 64

BYLAW NO. 2023-07

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE MUNICIPALITY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE VILLAGE OF KISBEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECEIVING CLEARING THE PATH FUNDING FOR GRID/HIGHWAY 605

The Rural Municipality of Brock No. 64, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw shall be referred to as the "Clearing The Path Funding-Village of Kisbey."
- 2. In this Bylaw:
 - a. "Administrator" shall mean the Administrator of the Rural Municipality of Brock No. 64;
 - b. "Council" shall mean the Council of the Rural Municipality of Brock No. 64;
 - c. "Reeve" shall mean the Reeve of the Rural Municipality of Brock No. 64;
 - d. "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Brock No. 64.
 - e. "Village" shall mean the Village of Kisbey
- 3. The Rural Municipality of Brock No. 64 is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Village of Kisbey in accordance with the terms of the Agreement.
- 4. The Agreement is attached hereto and forms a part of this Bylaw, and is identified as "Exhibit A."
- 5. The Reeve and the Administrator are hereby authorized to sign and seal the Agreement described as "Exhibit A".

RURAL INTEGRATED ROADS FOR GROWTH, CLEARING THE PATH FUNDING AGREEMENT

This agreement made in duplicate this 11th day of October, 2023, Between:

Village of Kisbey In the Province of Saskatchewan (Hereinafter referred to as the Village)

AND

The Rural Municipality of Brock No. 64 In the Province of Saskatchewan (Hereinafter referred to as the R.M.)

WHEREAS Rural Integrated Roads for Growth, Clearing The Path Corridor program, states that the roadway shall be the responsibility of the Municipality applying for the corridor;

WHEREAS the Rural Integrated Roads for Growth, Clearing The Path Corridor program, has established that the portion of the Clearing The Path Corridor located at the E 13-08-06 W2 is in the Village and therefore not the responsibility of the R.M.;

WHEREAS Rural Integrated Roads for Growth, Clearing The Path Corridor program, requires that the Village enter into an agreement for the portion of the Corridor within the Village (1.66km), resulting in the Village receiving incremental maintenance funding;

WHEREAS the R.M. has historically and is currently assuming all costs of maintenance for the entire Corridor, including the 1.66km that is the responsibility of the Village;

WHEREAS the R.M. and the Village are desirous of entering into an agreement to have the Rural Integrated Roads For Growth, Clearing The Path program funding received by the Village forwarded to the R.M.;

NOW THEREFORE, this agreement witnesses in consideration of the Mutual covenants on behalf of the parties hereto as follows:

PURPOSE

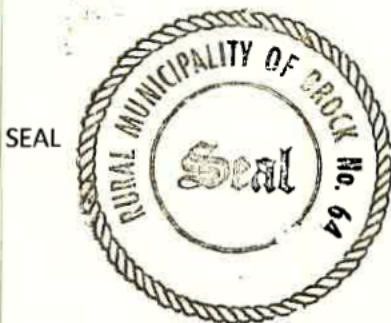
The Purpose of this Agreement is to have all Rural Integrated Roads For Growth, Clearing The Path Funding, received by the Village pertaining to the 1.66km of Corridor under the responsibility of the Village, forwarded to the R.M.

TERMS

Upon receiving the Rural Integrated Roads For Growth, Clearing The Path program funds, the Village shall forward the funds, in their entirety, to the R.M.

AMENDMENTS/DISSOLUTION

Either party to this agreement may request an amendment or dissolution of this agreement upon 30 days' notice to the other party.
