RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BROCK NO. 64

BYLAW NO. 2023-06

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR SETTING SPEED LIMITS ON ROADS WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Brock No. 64, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Bylaw is to set speed limits for all roads under the control of the Rural Municipality of Brock No. 64.

SHORT NAME

This bylaw shall be referred to as the "Speed Limit Bylaw".

DEFINITIONS

In this bylaw:

- a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
- b) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality;
- c) "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Brock No. 64
- d) "Motor Vehicles" shall mean as defined by *The Highway Traffic Act*, 1996
- e) "GVW" shall mean Gross Vehicle Weight as defined in *The Highway Traffic Act*, 1996

GENERAL

1. Highway 604 -The speed limit shall be set at and not exceed 60km per hour for all motor vehicles with a GVW of 10 tonnes and over, and motor vehicles 3 axels and more; and 90km per hour for all motor vehicles with a GVW under 10 tonnes, described as follows:

West of Section 3, Twp 7 Range 4 W2 West of Sections 3, 10, 15, 22, 27 and 34 Twp 8 Range 4 W2

2. Highway 605 – The speed limits shall be set at and not exceed 60km per hour for all motor vehicles with a GVW of 10 tonnes and over, and motor vehicles 3 axels and more; and 80km for all motor vehicles with a GVW under 10 tonnes described as follows:

West of Sections 7 and 6 Twp 8 Range 5 W2 West of Sections 31, 30, 19, 18, 7 and 6 Twp 7 Range 5 W2

- 3. RR 2063 The speed limit shall be set at and not exceed 60km per hour for ALL motor vehicles.
- 4. ALL Remaining Roads within the Rural Municipality of Brock No. 64 the speed limit shall be set at 60km per hour for motor vehicles with a GVW of 10 tonnes and over.

SIGNAGE

Signs indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be erected at the road entrance into the Rural Municipality.

VIOLATION

Any person found guilty of an infraction of the provisions of this Bylaw shall be liable to the penalties in Bylaw No. 2012-121, A Bylaw To Establish Penalties For Contravention Of Bylaws.


REPEAL
