

BYLAW NO. 2006-103

A BYLAW TO REGULATE ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Brock No. 64 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw, including this section:
 - (a) "all terrain vehicle" and/or "ATV" means all terrain vehicle as defined in The All Terrain Vehicle Act;
 - (b) "highway" means a highway as defined in The Highway Traffic Act and includes a road, parkway, driveway or place designed and intended for or used by the general public for the passage of vehicles, but does not include any area, whether privately or publicly owned, that is primarily intended to be used for the parking of vehicles and the necessary passageways on that area;
 - (c) "travelled portion" means a part of a highway designed for vehicle travel including the shoulder of the road;
2. A person is authorized to operate an all terrain vehicle on the traveled portion of any highway within the municipality only if it is related to agriculture and farming activities.
