WHEREAS the oil and gas industry are required to allocate funds for decommissioning of infrastructure, and there is a provincially managed orphan fund to clean up abandoned oil and gas sites;

BE IT RESOLVED that SARM lobby the Government of Saskatchewan and the Government of Canada to mandate alternative energy projects to allocate funds for end-of-life decommissioning in a similar format to the oil and gas industry;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the SARM lobby the Government of Saskatchewan and the Government of Canada to establish an orphan fund for the alternative energy industry to clean up abandoned alternative energy infrastructure.
