

BYLAW NO. 89-57

A BYLAW CONCERNING THE AGRICULTURE, DEVELOPMENT AND
DIVERSIFICATION BOARD

1. PURPOSE:

The purpose of this bylaw is to enable the council to enter an agreement with neighboring municipalities to work towards joint efforts in agriculture, development and diversification.

2. MUNICIPAL MEMBERSHIP ON DISTRICT BOARDS:

The Rural Municipality of Brock No. 64, by this bylaw, voluntarily makes application for membership on, and thereby enters into an inter-municipal agreement with the following neighboring municipalities, for operation of Agriculture, Development and Diversification District Board Number One (1); R.M.'s of Coalfields #4, Estevan #5, Cambria #6, Souris Valley #7, Browning #34, Benson #35, Cymri #36, and Tecumseh #65.

3. TERMS OF AGREEMENT:

The terms of the agreement are defined in the corporate bylaws of the Agriculture, Development and Diversification District Board No. One (1), which are attached as Exhibit A to this bylaw.
