


## BYLAW NO. 2013-127

### A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH VEHICLES WEIGHTS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Brock No. 64 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The purpose of this bylaw is to (i) establish vehicle weights to regulate the weight of vehicles, or vehicles with their loads using municipal highways or any particular municipal highways in the municipality and (ii) to designate routes within the municipality that any vehicle or class of vehicles is required to use when driving in the municipality.
2. That all roads, excluding the exemptions listed below, within the limits of the R.M. of Brock No. 64 shall be set at primary weights as set in *The Saskatchewan Vehicle Weights and Dimensions Regulations*.
3. Exemptions: The following roads have regulated weights as follows:  
  
Maximum 13 tonnes including load:
  - Highway #604
  - Starting at Range Road 2061 to Range Road 2064 on Township Road 80
4. Any person found guilty of an infraction of the provisions of this Bylaw shall be liable to the penalties in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
5. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon third reading.






